Requirements

- Knowledge of Ignatian Spirituality (some coursework in Ignatian Spirituality is preferable)
- Personal/working experience with Ignatian Spirituality, including: retreats, working for or educated in an Ignatian institution
- Cultural awareness and sensitivity-- the ability to live and actively engaging in cultures different than one's own.
- Good physical health (the pilgrimage will include 7 days of intense walking through mountainous regions as well as city road)
- Ability to live and to travel simply
- Ready and willingly to participate in an intentional faith community openly and prayerfully (faith sharing, communal prayer, liturgy)
- Work on a personal autobiography and present/share it with other pilgrims in the class.
- *Please submit a two-page essay stating why you want to participate in this course. How would this Camino enrich your theological formation? What do you hope to gain after having completed this course and the pilgrimage? What would be some of the challenging aspects of the Camino as you envision it?*

Cost for the program:

- Estimated Program Cost per Student: \$1000*
The program costs include: tuition, housing, 3 meals/day, and local transportation in

Spain

- This cost is projected only and is subject to the number of participants.
Students should not purchase any non-refundable plane tickets or make any other non-refundable reservations until the program is confirmed.
- Students should plan for the following estimated costs not included in the program fee:
 - Transportation from Berkeley to San Francisco and metro in Madrid ~ \$100
 - Books \$150
 - Incidentals \$150
 - ✓ This may be high but would include things like snacks, water, access to an internet cafe, personal spending money, etc.
- Each student who is accepted for this course will be required to pay a non-refundable deposit of \$750.00. I am working with the school and outside grants to assist with these costs. Additional funding is pending. Fundraising is required for all participants to lower the cost for the program.
- Number of participants: ~ 12 students.
